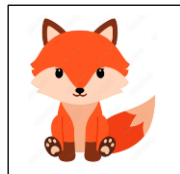


Welcome back Foxes

We hope you all had a lovely Easter break. Welcome back to the new Summer term. Please find below some helpful information about our learning over this term.

















PE:

What will my child be learning? Summer Curriculum Coverage:

Our theme this half term is 'Once Upon a Time'. During our theme, we will be exploring Kings and Queens and learn how and where they are crowned. We will be talking about famous landmarks in London and where they are in relation to one another using maps. We will also be learning about plants and talking about what they need to help them grow. We will look forward to planting beans, potatoes and sunflowers too. Our focus book will be 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

Next half term our topic will be 'Let's Explore our Wonderful World.' We will talk a lot about where different countries are in relation to where we live. We will explore and celebrate different cultures and discuss various forms of transport. Our focus book will be 'Handa's Surprise'.
