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Sports Premium Report

From September 2013, all schools have been provided with funding to support the Olympic legacy and to enable the delivery of effective sports provision. Within the Diocese of Salisbury Academy Trust we aim to provide high quality sport. At St James' CE First School, over a number of years we have provided the following;

- Access to high quality coaching in a range of sports.
- Professional development for staff to enable them to teach PE more effectively
- Specialist teachers and coaches to broaden the pupils' experience of other sports.
- Additional PE resources to support the delivery of high quality
- Provided a range of Extra-curricular clubs to develop skills and broaden children's experiences.
- Implemented and installed a daily mile track for all children to participate on.
- Enter a variety of different competitions and festivals for children to participate in.
